REGIONAL INNOVATION STRATEGY FOR SMART SPECIALISATION (RIS3)

- linking knowledge resources to a limited number of priority economic activities
- take advantage of scale, scope and spillovers in knowledge production and use
- ensure stakeholders involvement in a bottom-up process of entrepreneurial discovery (to make use of tacit knowledge)


CHALLENGES FOR IMPLEMENTING RIS3 IN MAZOVIA

- too many entities to take into account (over 800,000 companies, several dozen research institutes and universities)
- no clear industrial specialisation in the voivodeship
- not enough administrative resources
- too little 'social capital' and trust among stakeholders
- little interest of the largest entities in cooperation at the regional level (very limited financing from the ROP)

THE IDEA OF WORKING GROUPS

MAIN TASKS OF THE WORKING GROUPS

- to provide ongoing suport for RIS3 managing authority
- to ensure compliance of smart specialisation areas with the **needs** of entrepreneurs
- to identify niches for smart specialisation, areas of experimentation and future development, e.g. regional research priorities
- to give opinion on RIS implementation documents: implementation programmes, rules of calls for projects, etc.
- to discuss support instruments aimed at solving specific problems in the areas of smart specialisation





PRINCIPLES TO KEEP THE GROUPS RUNNING

- no special conditions for joining and participation - we cooperate with anyone who can commit their time
- can join at any time
- two parallel work paths: real life meetings and the Internet (email, online documents)
- collective nature of the solutions every voice counts, but each individual has to convince other members
- ad hoc task teams to discuss some issues in more detail
- minimum level of moderation necessary to sustain the discussion without disturbing it with the local government point of view





WORKING GROUPS IN NUMBERS

- started in 2014
- 4 groups, each focusing on one regional smart specialisation thematic area: safe food, intelligent management systems, modern business services, high quality of life
- 4 task teams: space industry, cosmetics, packaging, education
- about 300 entrepreneurs participating
- 3 editions of research priorities for regional smart specialisation in Mazovia
- 9 strategic workshops on updating the Mazowieckie's RIS3 strategy – direct involvement in setting vision, goals and actions for the new edition of the strategy
- 100+ meetings until now





Spillover effect of the working groups

- informal contacts during meetings
- exchange of ideas among stakeholders
- constantly developed contact database
 expanding the reach of information on the development initiatives
- more business-oriented approach in regional strategic documents
- ideas for some branch-oriented analysis in scope of RIS3: photonics, space industry, agri-food sector, packaging
